3. Liability

The event organizers (or any of its officials or members) will not be liable or responsible for any personal injury.

Coaches and team leaders ensure that all participants are physically fit, prepared, and capable of coping with the tournament. We strongly recommend proper medical and accident insurance. Competitors compete at their own risk.

As stated in JJIF SC, § 2.5, Each JJNO is directly responsible for its athletes (including the control of non-pregnancy). It must undertake all responsibility for accident- and health insurance and civil liabilities during all JJIF events for everyone under its charge.

4. Rules and draw

The following rules apply:

- JJIF competition rules (in their latest versions), Sporting code of JJIF Version 1.1.1 (SC).¹
- We appeal to all participants to respect the fair-play and JJIF book of ethics.

4.1. Draw modus

The seeding and draw-in-bock will be made on 30/01/2025 20:00².

Immediately after the draw has been finalized, the categories will be made available online on the Sportdata Event Website. JJNOs have the right to request minor changes³ in the following 2 hours, in writing, to the organizing committee.

Major changes⁴ must be requested according to the following⁵:

- At official international championships, **no redraw** is possible, except for unforeseen cases when the JJIF Board may decide on a redraw.
- A redraw can be requested max. 2 hours after the draw was published but, in any case, before the start of the competition, **in writing**, to the JJIF Sports Director.

Seeding regulations of the JJIF will be observed. For the seeding, JJIF will use the 10th January 2025 world ranking list. The JJNOs are responsible for making sure all points are correct in ranking list until this day.

4.2. Appeal and Challenge

Will be applied as defined in JJIF SC § 4.4 Challenge and Appeal.

5. Right to participate and categories

Based on the JJIF SC, § 2.4 Entries of Competitors: there is no maximum for the event.

Contact Ju Jitsu will adopt JJIF competition rules Head Impact Free: please register in the Adult category.

5.1. Categories

The age following age divisions⁶ will be allowed to participate in this event.

Official JJIF Weight categories will be used.⁹

5.2. Accreditation

Control of entries and issuing of accreditation cards will take place at the main official hotel on Thursday, 30th of January 2025, during registration. At least one team official must attend in time to confirm the

presence of all athletes and officials. The team official must be able to show all official documents and passports of all team members (copies are accepted).

Accreditations for coaches will be available at the draw and the coach meeting on Thursday.

An accreditation card shall be issued to all competitors, officials and crew members and should be carried at all times.

6. Registration and Participation Fee

6.1. Registration

6.2. Participation Fee

Genoa Open Regional (U18, U21 and Adults) - JJIF Ranking list

- Fighting system - 100 €/competitor
- Duo and Show - 100 €/couple
- Jiu-Jitsu - 100 €/competitor
- Contact Ju Jitsu – only Adult category - 100 €/competitor
- Para Jiu Jitsu and Inclusive self-defense – only Adult category - 100 €/competitor/couple

Genoa Open Championship (U16,U14):

- Fighting system - 80 €/competitor
- Duo and show system - 80 €/couple
- Jiu-Jitsu - 80 €/competitor

The amounts must be paid to the Organizing Committee on the deadline.

Deadline for applications and payments: 10/01/2025.

Nations missing the registration deadline will be allowed to participate paying 20 € fee (for each athlete/couple) for late entry until 23/01/2025.

Other fees

- Change (of an injured) competitor until the registration deadline: free
- Change (of an injured) competitor after the registration deadline (in the same category): 20 €
- Change of the category of an athlete until the registration deadline: free
- Change of the category of an athlete after the registration deadline: 20 €
- Change on the day of Competition are not possible
- Additional competitor entry on-site: 50 €

7. Anti-doping Control

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be doping control for several athletes. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations.¹⁰

If you are participating in the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2024 Prohibited List.¹¹

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJIF automatically recognizes all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so don't hesitate to get in touch with your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, don't hesitate to get in touch with the JJIF.

8. Competition Dressing, Personal Requirements and Advertising

Participant are requested to fulfill JJIF rules about dressing and personal requirements.¹²

9. Referees

OC will provide hotel room from Thursday evening to Sunday morning included and all meals for all referees that have been selected by JJIF for the event.

Referees can apply via Sports ID for the event: www.sportdata.org (deadline 25th November 2024).

All referees will be waitlisted first. The Technical Commission (Head referee of Discipline) will decide about participation in consideration of Discipline, Availability, License level, Gender equality aspects, and country, continental and age mix.

Referees are requested to plan their voyages considering that there will be 3 (three) days of competition. Transport is covered by the participating referees or their JJNO.

Referees selected by JJIF for the event will be refunded for travel expenses up to 100 € by completing the expense report and attaching the travel documents.

Referees are also requested to attend the briefing as detailed in Referee outlines.

According to JJIF sporting codes minimum 50% of attending referees must have an international license. Referees not selected to be part of 50% with international license are also welcome to participating in event but the organization will not recovery any expenses.

As agreed with JJIF, Referee Course and examinations for Continental Licenses will be schedule for all disciplines.

Further information will be provided in Referee outlines.

10. Coaches from JJNOs

10.1. Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the

field of play unless they register as coaches).

10.2. Dress code

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses¹³; shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed.

Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not allowed without press accreditation.

According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person.

11. Flags and Anthems

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible for each national federation, must check the flag and the national anthem during the accreditation process.
